Subject: Weapons in School

Policy:

The Red River Valley School Division Board of Trustees believes in a school environment free from the presence of weapons and other dangerous items.

Protocol:

All weapons and other dangerous items which may be used to harm others are prohibited on all school property, at all school functions, and while travelling to and from school unless approved by School Administration for specified purposes.

Procedure:

Students who are in possession of weapons/items (guns, bombs, etc.) on all school property, at all school functions, and while travelling to and from school **shall** be:

- a) suspended immediately from school by the School Administrator or his designate.
- b) reported to the RCMP immediately.

Students who are in possession of weapons/items (knives, flammable substances, etc.) on all school property, at all school functions and while travelling to and from school **may** be:

- a) suspended by the School Administrator.
- b) reported to the RCMP.

All incidents shall be investigated by the School Administrator and communicated to the Superintendent & CEO.

Students may be suspended from 1 to 5 days. . In cases of a severe nature, the Administrator will consult with the Superintendent & CEO as to what course of action to follow. This action may vary from further suspensions of up to 6 weeks with counseling, to a recommendation to the Board of Trustees for expulsion.
